

# CHANGE A CLIENT'S PROGRAMME START DATE

To check whether a client is associated with your programme, find the client record, then select Action/Programmes. You will see something like this:-Client: Count Duckula (Duc127996)

### If your programme is not in the list, then either:-

- You haven't completed a Registration Wizard for the client. • In this case select Action/Wizards, click on New Wizard and complete the registration wizard.
- You have completed a wizard for the client but have forgotten to select a programme • in the wizard.

In this case only you can edit the Wizard using the second method below.

If your programme is in the list but the Programme Start Date is wrong, use the first method below to update.

### HOW TO CHANGE A PROGRAMME START DATE IN THE CLIENT RECORD

- Find the Client Record •
- Select Action/Programmes •
- You'll see a list of one or more Programmes, like this:-**Client Programmes** red against client

- Click on the Edit link for the relevant Programme. ٠ NB Do not click on the programme name, if you do, you'll be editing the overall dates of the Programme, not the date the client started on the programme.
- You'll see a screen like this:-

  - Scroll down and click on Edit
  - Change the Activity Date and click on Save.

## HOW TO CHANGE A PROGRAMME START DATE IN A WIZARD

- Find the Client Record, either in Client/Find Client or Quick Jump List
- Select Action/Wizards
- Click on the correct Wizard Name
